RE: Notification Requirement per Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act

Idaho Falls School District 91 is required by 40 CFR Part 763.84, the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) to:

- “Ensure that workers and building occupants, organizations, or parent teacher organizations, are informed at least once each school year about inspections, response actions, and post response actions activities, including periodic re-inspections and surveillance activities that are planned or are in progress.”
- “Ensure that short term workers (e.g. phone repair workers, utility repair workers, or exterminators) who may come in contact with asbestos in a school are provided information regarding the location of asbestos containing building material (ACBM) and suspected or assumed ACBM.”

The following District 91 buildings contain known or suspected asbestos containing materials:

Each of above named buildings has an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) that is available for review. District Operations is in the process of moving the AMPs to the Environmental Safety website located at www.d91.k12.id.us/index.php?option=com_content&view=category&id=110&Itemid=619. AMP's can be found at the office of each building, on the District web site or in the ES&H office located at 625 7th Street, Idaho Falls, Idaho. The AMP for buildings that are in the process of being changed over to electronic format is located in the ES&H Specialist's office. The AMP for the District Warehouse is in Warehouse office and in the office of the Environmental Safety & Health Specialist for the remaining buildings.

The Maintenance and Operations Plan, Section IV of the Asbestos Management Plan describes how ACM is contained and maintained to ensure the environment in each building is kept safe. Asbestos surveillances are performed every six months by head custodians and/or trained asbestos inspectors. The three year re-inspections are ongoing, with a portion of the district buildings done each year. These inspections are conducted by accredited School District 91 and/or contractor personnel.


Principals, Directors and Supervisors or their designees are required to inform any outside contractor, repairman, etc., who may come in contact with asbestos containing material or suspect asbestos containing material in an Idaho Falls School District 91 building, of the locations of ACM in that building.

During the calendar year 2012, the following facilities will have asbestos-related work performed:

- Administration Building – Data Center upgrade and asbestos floor tile abatement (Completed in March, 2012)
- Eagle Rock Jr. High School – Front entry floor tile abatement and replacement with carpet (Completed March, 2012)
- Clair E. Gale Jr. High School (New Tech High School) – Various abatement projects including floor tile, pipe insulation, ceiling panels, etc. to be completed as renovations take place during the summer of 2012 and 2013
- Idaho Falls High School – Abatement of floor tile in hallways and some classrooms on the main level to be completed as renovations take place during the summer of 2012

Notification Requirement per Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act

- 3-year re-inspections of Templeview Elementary School, Eagle Rock Jr. High School, Westside Elementary School, Skyline High School, Hawthorne Elementary School, Idaho Fall High School Music Annex, East and West Stadiums, and outbuildings and trailers associated with Skyline High School and Eagle Rock Jr. High School.
