Congratulations to team Tinker Thinkers for placing 3rd at the FabSLAM Showcase in Pocatello on Saturday, March 10th! The team worked for seven weeks developing and documenting a product to address this year's theme challenge of "transportation". They practiced design thinking, iteration and rapid prototyping focused on creating their 3D design of a bubble disk/blade used to help produce cleaner emissions.

The showcase was made possible through a grant the Taylorview Media Center received supported by the Idaho STEM Action Center. The media center received a 3D printer, staff training, \$1600 for continued support materials and an additional \$200 for 3rd place. The 3D printer is a welcome addition to the media center for all student and staff use.
