Celebration/Git R' Done Day

Friday, March 9th, 1:45 – 3:35 p.m.

(We will be on an alternate bell schedule this day . Watch for more information.)

This is a day we set aside at the end of 1st and 2nd trimesters to celebrate students who have passed all of their classes for the trimester, and also to provide small group and one-on-one instructional support to help students who did not pass a class or classes for that trimester.

Students who have passed all of their classes for the trimester will have a choice to attend the following activities:

- Dance in the Gym
- Movie in the Auditorium
- Games in the Cafeteria
- Maker Station/Silent Reading in the Media Center

Students who have failed one or more classes will be assigned to a classroom to receive extended support which provides the opportunity for them to regain credit for failed classes and to change their failing grade to passing. As you may be aware, Idaho State Law requires that all middle school students pass a minimum of 80% of the credits attempted in a school year and that students must not fail all three trimesters of a core class in order to advance to the next grade

level. Any students who do not meet this criteria are at risk of repeating the same grade level the following school year.

It is our goal to provide the necessary support and materials to ensure that all of our Taylorview students pass on to the next grade level. So, our teachers will put together Remediation Packets for all students who have failed a class. These Remediation Packets are individualized to meet individual students needs and remediate the specific content standards each individual student did not pass with proficiency. Students who successfully complete a Remediation Packet for a failed class can then regain credit and a passing grade once they demonstrate proficiency on the identified standards.

We appreciate your support in our efforts to provide this extended instructional opportunity for our students, so that all Taylorview students are successful.
