**Substitutions are fine** if you don't have the items listed. There are no specific colors.

**Some ideas include:**

**Boys:**

**Jeans**

**Tops:** Button-up shirts-plaid, striped or solid, or plain white t-shirts (can roll sleeve hem twice), or long or short-sleeved shirts-can be plain or patterned, if possible without big words or pictures on the front.

**Possible accessories:** Leather-style jacket, or jeans jacket. White socks. Sneakers-if you happen to have Keds or Converse style sneakers they are a great choice in both regular and high-top.

**Hair:** Can slick hair back if desired. Definitely not required.

**Girls:**

**Skirt**(try for knee-length or below the knee) **or jeans, or black pants/leggings.**

**Tops:** Button-up shirt-can be plain or patterned, long or short sleeve t-shirt or sweater (solid colors if you have them)—try to avoid big words or pictures on the front.

**Possible accessories:** Button-up cardigan sweater. Small scarf tied around neck. White ankle socks- other colors are fine. Shoes can be Mary Jane style, or sneakers-especially Keds or Converse type, or other styles you may have.

**Hair:** Ponytail (back of the head in the middle), large ribbon or small scarf tied around ponytail (no bow- tie a knot and let the rest hang down). Shorter hair may have a headband or ribbon headband if desired.

**Favorite colors:** pink, white, black. Other pastel colors. Any color you choose will be fine.

If you happen to have a 50's costume, poodle skirt, etc. this is a great time to wear it again.
