Experiment with your camera, smartphone, or tablet.	<b>Metropolitan Museum of Art Virtual Tours</b> Choose and then create your own copy of your favorite artwork.
<b>Observational Drawing:</b> Set up and draw a Still Life arrangement OR Open a drawer and draw what you see in it.	Collect toys, shoes, kitchen items, etc and arrange them into a <b>Color Wheel</b> - Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Purple!	Keep a <b>Nature Journal!</b> Draw from life: pets & animals, people, plants, both inside and out!	<b>Photo Scavenger Hunt!</b> Make a list of items to capture, then take a walk to collect them! (Example: blue car, ball, red sock...)	<b>Art for Kids Hub</b> (YouTube) Draw along!

Perfect or learn to fold <b>Paper Airplanes.</b> Decorate them, and have a contest to judge their flying abilities!	<b>FREE</b>	Learn to upload your pics to your computer. Make a <b>Collage</b> by inserting them into a Google Doc or Word document. Give your collage a theme and title!	<b>Mo Willems Lunch Doodles</b> (YouTube) Draw along with Mo and learn about how he creates his books!!
<b>Illustrate</b> your latest writing assignment, or the book you're currently reading. Draw the story as you imagine it!	Make a <b>3-D Sculpture</b> with recycled containers, boxes, and TP tubes!	<b>Sidewalk Chalk!</b> Happy Word Art messages for people walking by, Trace your silhouette in a Ninja kick or dance move, Or just draw what makes you happy!	<b>Pixel Pictures</b> Open Google Sheets or Xcel. Adjust the size of the cells to be small squares, then fill them with color to create a Pixel Picture!	Watch tutorials for a <b>Needlecraft</b> (crocheting, knitting, card stitching, etc) Give it a try!
<b>Magazine Drawings</b> Cut part of a picture from a magazine, glue it on a paper, and draw something new to complete the picture!	Use an old sock or brown lunch bag to make a <b>Puppet.</b> Add details, decorate, and dress up your puppet, then put on a puppet show!	Plan and prepare a <b>Garden Bed or Pot</b> for planting. When planting time comes, plant seeds to start a living work of Art!	<b>Drawing &amp; Paint Apps</b> Use your computer or tablet's Paint program to doodle and draw, or to open and alter one of your photographs!	Watch tutorials to learn to make <b>Origami</b> folded paper sculptures, and give it a try!
